Below is an overview of the registration process for becoming a member of the College of Medical Laboratory Technologists of Manitoba (CMLTM). Only registered members of CMLTM can use the title "Medical Laboratory Technologist," or the initials "MLT" after their name in the province of Manitoba. This overview is provided as a guide. Please visit www.cmltm.ca for further details on each step.

Note: **Please contact CMLTM before starting the process.** Timelines are estimated. All fees are listed in Canadian dollars (2026). Fees are estimates and do not include costs associated with travel, meeting documentation criteria, etc.

	CAMLPR will assess your application package and write a technical report that states whether your education is equivalent to Canadian standards: - if your education and MLT experience is deemed to be equivalent, you can apply for the CMLTM Conditional Registration, which allows you to practice as a Medical Laboratory Technologist under supervision and register for the CAMLPR field-of-practice examinations - if your education and MLT experience is not deemed equivalent, you will be required to complete a learning plan for required gap education or an approved MLT bridging program.		

Step 2: Field of Practice Exams (administered by CAMLPR on behalf of CMLTM)

2 – 4 months	a) Register for CAMLPR field-of-practice exam(s)	\$475-989	If you have been approved by CAMLPR to write the Exam, you are eligible for a Conditional registration which will be valid for two exam attempts or 9 months (whichever comes first). Conditional registration allows you to work under supervision until you pass an exam in the applicable field-of-practice

	e) Completion of required eLearning modules		*First time applicants received after June 1 st will be eligible for fee adjustment. CMLTM will assess your application. If all requirements are met, your registration will be approved, you will be placed on the Active: Practicing roster and issued a Certificate to Practice.
