Professional Practice Seminars (PPS) for Internationally Educated Health Professionals

What are the Professional Practice Seminars (PPS)?

The Professional Practice Seminars (PPS) are a series of training seminars (modules) designed to provide Internationally Educated Health Professionals (IEHPs) with an introduction to workplace culture and communication in Canada. These seminars have been designed specifically for IEHPs by the Office of the Manitoba Fairness Commissioner (OMFC), in consultation with practicing health care professionals, educators, regulators and businesses.

The Professional Practice Seminars are delivered in a workshop style and provide participants with the opportunity to learn and engage in activities designed to increase their awareness and understanding of workplace culture and communication in the context of health care in Canada.

The Professional Practice Seminars include the following modules:

- Pre-Module: Introduction to the Canadian Health Care System (Optional, self-study)
- Module 1: Cross-Cultural Awareness (*Self-awareness and Non-verbal Communication*), Part 1
- Module 2: Cross-Cultural Awareness (*Cultural Orientations*), Part 2
- Module 3: Developing Relational (Soft) Skills in a Canadian Context (*Professional Communication*), Part 1
- Module 4: Developing Relational (Soft) Skills in a Canadian Context (*Therapeutic Communication; Conflict Management*), Part 2

Am I eligible to participate in the Professional Practice Seminars (PPS) for Internationally Educated Health Professionals (IEHPs)?

In order to participate in the PPS for IEHPs, you must:

- Be an internationally educated health professional (Nurses and Doctors are *not* eligible.)
- Have begun your registration process as an IEHP in Manitoba
- Have advanced English language proficiency (CLB 7+)
- Be interested in learning about workplace culture and communication in the context of health care in Canada

If you are unsure about your eligibility to participate in the PPS for IEHPs, please contact your regulatory organization for more information.

Is participation in the Professional Practice Seminars (PPS) *required* for registration in my health profession?

No; participation in the PPS is *optional*. It is not required for registration (licensing).

Additionally, the PPS are informational only. They are not a replacement for any requirement of the registration process with your regulatory organization. They are designed to support your success in the workplace.
