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Guide for Canadian Educated Applicants

To work as a Medical Laboratory Technologist (MLT) in the province of Manitoba an individual is required to be registered with the College of Medical Laboratory Technologists of Manitoba (CMLTM).

The CMLTM was established in 2007 by the proclamation of The Medical Laboratory Technologists Act. This Act requires anyone with the intent to practice Medical Laboratory Technology in the Province of Manitoba to be registered with the CMLTM. MLTs must practice their profession in accordance with the CMLTM regulations, standards and meet the continuing competency requirements. This protects the public's right to safe, effective, ethical service from Medical Laboratory Technologists.

Requirements for Conditional Certificate of Registration (Canadian Educated Applicants)

- 1) Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident of Canada, or have an authorization under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (Canada)
- 2) Have a Canadian diploma/degree in Medical Laboratory Technology from a Canadian Medical Association (CMA) conjoint accredited program
- 3) Eligible to write the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science (CSMLS) MLT examination

Requirements for Conditional Certificate of Registration (Internationally Educated Applicant)

- 1) Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident of Canada, or have an authorization under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (Canada) to work in Canada
- 2) Have a Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) by CSMLS and completion of gap education identified (information on PLA process available on CSMLS website, www.csmls.org, click on the International Technologists tab)
- 3) Eligible to write the CSMLS MLT examination

Conditions for Conditional Certificate of Registration

- 1) Must practice Medical Laboratory Technology under the direct-on-site supervision of a MLT holding a valid Active Certificate to Practice in the Province of Manitoba



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- 2) May be referred to as a Medical Laboratory Technologist and use the title MLT in the Province of Manitoba
- 3) Must upgrade from Conditional to Active Certificate of Registration before beginning to practice Medical Laboratory Technology without direct-on-site supervision.
- 4) A Conditional Certificate of Registration is valid for 9 months or 2 attempts at the CSMLS MLT examination

Documents Required for Application to Conditional Certificate to Practice (Canadian Educated Applicant)

- 1) Current CMLTM Renewal/Application form completed (available at www.cmltm.ca) and applicable fees
- 2) Copy of transcript from MLT diploma/degree
- 3) Copy of CSMLS letter of eligibility to challenge the CSMLS MLT examination
- 4) Copy of Canadian government issued photo identification (driver's license or passport)
- 5) Criminal record check (with vulnerable sector check)
- 6) Child abuse registry check
- 7) Adult abuse registry check

Documents Required for Application to Conditional Certificate to Practice (Internationally Educated Applicant)

- 1) Current CMLTM Renewal/Application form completed (available at www.cmltm.ca) and applicable fees
- 2) Official sealed copy of PLA report from CSMLS
- 3) Copy of CSMLS letter of eligibility to challenge the CSMLS MLT examination
- 4) Copy of Canadian government issued photo identification (driver's license, passport or permanent resident card)
- 5) Criminal record check (with vulnerable sector check)
- 6) Child abuse registry check
- 7) Adult abuse registry check
