Discipline decisions, voluntary surrenders and censures are designated as public information in the regulations and as such may be published by the Complaints Committee and must appear in the register.

The Complaints Committee will forward all decisions/findings to the CEO/Registrar who is responsible to update the register.

The following information is contained in the register and is available during normal business hours:

- The results of every disciplinary proceeding completed within six years before the register was prepared or last updated
- Situations in which a Medical Laboratory Technologist's certificate of registration was cancelled or suspended or had conditions imposed on it, or
- Situations in which a Medical Laboratory Technologist was required to pay a fine or attend to be censured;
- Information designated as public in the regulations.

The Complaints Committee may publish the fact that a member has been disciplined, and publication may include the member's name and the reasons that led to the discipline.

The Complaints Committee may publish the fact that a member has voluntarily surrendered his or her registration, and publication may include the member's name and the reasons that led to the voluntary surrender of registration.
