**Practicing without Proper Registration**

The College of Medical Laboratory Technologists of Manitoba (CMLTM) must carry out its activities in a manner that serves and protects the Public interest. The CMLTM must ensure all practicing Medical Laboratory Technologists (MLT) are qualified to practice as an MLT and are registered with the appropriate and valid Certificate to Practice as specified in section 9(1) of the Medical Laboratory Technologist Act and section 4(1) of the Medical Laboratory Technologists Regulations.

Once the Registrar has become aware that a person has been practising as an MLT or holding themselves out as an MLT without a valid Certificate to Practice, the Registrar will inform the person in question, the employer, Manitoba Health, and Council.

Council will impose a \$500 fine to the person in question. This fine must be paid in addition to any other fees normally assessed for registration/renewal including any fees for re-instatement.
