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### **Guide for Canadian Educated Applicants**

To work as a Medical Laboratory Technologist (MLT) in the province of Manitoba an individual is required to be registered with the College of Medical Laboratory Technologists of Manitoba (CMLTM).

The CMLTM was established in 2007 by the proclamation of The Medical Laboratory Technologists Act. This Act requires anyone with the intent to practice Medical Laboratory Technology in the Province of Manitoba to be registered with the CMLTM. MLTs must practice their profession in accordance with the CMLTM regulations, standards and meet the continuing competency requirements. This protects the public's right to safe, effective, ethical service from Medical Laboratory Technologists.

#### **Requirements for Active Certificate of Registration**

- 1) Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident of Canada, or have an authorization under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (Canada)
- 2) Have a Canadian diploma/degree in Medical Laboratory Technology from a Accreditation Canada HSO-EQUAL accredited program
- 3) Met the English Language Proficiency requirements as outlined in [BOA-17](#)
- 4) Successful completion of the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science (CSMLS) MLT examination
- 5) Have been actively engaged in the practice of Medical Laboratory Technology for 1200 hours during the five (5) years immediately preceding the date of the application. Please refer to re-entry to practice policy if recent MLT practice is longer than five years.

#### **Requirements for Inactive Certificate of Registration**

- 1) Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident of Canada, or have an authorization under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (Canada)
- 2) Have a Canadian diploma/degree in Medical Laboratory Technology from a Accreditation Canada HSO-EQUAL accredited program
- 3) Successful completion of the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science (CSMLS) MLT examination
- 4) Been previously registered in the Active category



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### **Conditions for Inactive Certificate of Registration**

- 1) May not practice Medical Laboratory Technology in the Province of Manitoba
- 2) May not be referred to as a Medical Laboratory Technologist (MLT) or use the title in the province of Manitoba
- 3) Must upgrade from Inactive to Active Certificate of Registration before beginning to practice Medical Laboratory Technology in Manitoba or begin to use the title Medical Laboratory Technologist (MLT)

### **Documents Required for Application to Active Certificate to Practice**

- 1) Current CMLTM Application form completed (available at [www.cmltm.ca](http://www.cmltm.ca)) and applicable fees
- 2) Copy of transcript from MLT diploma/degree
- 3) Evidence of English Language Proficiency as outlined in [BOA-17](#)
- 4) Copy of CSMLS MLT certificate or exam results
- 5) Copy of Canadian government issued photo identification (drivers license or passport)
- 6) If applicant is currently registered or has previously been registered (in the last 5 years) as an MLT in another regulated Province, a Letter of Standing from the Regulatory Body of that Province must be provided
- 7) Criminal record check (with vulnerable sector check)
- 8) Child abuse registry check
- 9) Adult abuse registry check
